Membership

Membership is open to anyone 50 years of age or older. The fee for new members is forty dollars (\$40) per year for an individual member and sixty dollars (\$60) per year for two individuals residing at the same address. The membership fee for all current members in good standing is thirty-five (\$35) dollars per year for an individual and fifty dollars (\$50) per year for two individuals residing at the same address. If a current membership lapses, a sixty-day grace period for renewal will be granted. If a member does not renew within the sixty-day grace period, the membership fee increase will be applied. A discount of five dollars (\$5) is offered to eligible veterans. Seniors ninety years of age and older are exempt from membership fee. The Membership Office is open Monday through Friday from 9:00am-11:30am. We accept cash, checks, and credit cards. If you would like to join or renew your membership by mail, please include a stamped, self-addressed envelope for your membership card (non-photo) to be returned. Members must present membership card to receive discounted rates.
