#### PROPERTY TAX RELIEF ASSISTANCE Date: Thursday, May 5, 2016 Time: 9:00am-1:30pm

AARP tax volunteers will be available to assist those who may qualify to receive a refund from the state of NH on the 2015 property taxes they paid to their city or town. To qualify for tax relief, the Adjustable Gross Income (AGI) for single filers must be \$20,000.00 or less, or \$40,000.00 or less for married or head of household filing status. AGI can be found on line 37 of Form 1040, line 21 of 1040-A or line 4 for 1040-EZ filers. This is a free service, and there is no age limit. You must bring a copy of your final property tax bill for 2015 and a copy of your 2015 federal income tax return for each adult over 18 who owns or resides in the home. No preregistration required.


#### **Health and Wellness Community Offerings**

#### <u>Membership</u>
