NEW AQUATICS PROGRAM BEING DEVELOPED

We are pleased to announce the receipt of two grants to fund the introduction of an Aquatic Exercise Program at the Nashua Senior Activity Center. The **Ann DeNicola Trust, Citizens Bank, N.A., Trustee** and the **Ella F. Anderson Trust, BNY Mellon, N. A., Trustee** have both funded the program with grants for \$4,000 and \$7,500 respectively.
