Taxpayers should come prepared with their social security card or statement, picture ID, and 2018 tax return if possible. They should be prepared to fill out a short questionnaire designed to assist the AARP volunteer in preparing the return. Volunteer tax return preparers are forbidden from accepting monetary compensation of any kind. Certain complicated tax returns are considered "out of scope" and cannot be prepared by the volunteers. AGI can be found on line 7 of your Form 1040 tax return. You must bring a copies of your property tax bill for 2018 and 2018 Federal Income Tax Return for each adult over 18 who owns or resides in the home.
