NASHUA SENIOR ACTIVITY CENTER <u>Updated COVID-19 Recommendations and Guidelines</u>

The population we serve at The Nashua Senior Activity Center falls into the high risk category and therefore it is <u>highly recommended</u> that visitors <u>continue to wear a mask</u> while using our facility to protect their own health as well as the health of our members, volunteers, staff and guests.

In accordance with the updated guidelines from the City of Nashua, members, program participants and staff of The Nashua Senior Activity Center who are <u>fully vaccinated</u> may utilize our facilities and participate in programs without a face mask. However, mask wearing is encouraged and visitors or staff who wish to continue to wear a mask will be fully supported.

Fully vaccinated is defined as:

- 2 weeks after the second dose in a 2-dose series, such as the Pfizer or Moderna vaccines
- OR
- 2 weeks after a single-dose vaccine, such as Johnson & Johnson's Janssen vaccine

If you do not meet the above requirements, you are <u>NOT</u> considered fully vaccinated and <u>are required to wear a mask</u> <u>when inside our facility</u>. We will not be requiring proof of vaccination but are relying on the integrity of our members and guests to follow this guidance based on their vaccination status.

Additional sanitizing stations are located throughout the building (frequent hand washing is encouraged)
