NSAC Updated COVID-19 Recommendations and Guidelines

Due to the rapid and alarming rise in COVID 19 cases, the CDC has issued new updated guidance on the use of masks in public indoor settings. To further reduce the risk of becoming infected with the Delta variant and transmitting it to others, it now recommends everyone in areas of substantial or high community transmission wear a mask in public indoor settings, even if they are fully vaccinated.

The population we serve at The Nashua Senior Activity Center falls into the high risk category and therefore it is highly recommended that all visitors continue-to-wear-a-mask while using our facility to protect their own health as well as the health of our members, volunteers, staff and guests.

In accordance with the guidelines from the City of Nashua, members, program participants and staff of The Nashua Senior Activity Center who are fully vaccinated may utilize our facilities and participate in programs without a face mask. However, mask wearing is strongly encouraged and visitors or staff who wish to continue to wear a mask will be fully supported. Fully vaccinated is defined as:

 2 weeks after the second dose in a 2-dose series, such as the Pfizer or Moderna vaccines or 2 weeks after a single-dose vaccine, such as Johnson & Johnson's Janssen vaccine.

If you do not meet the above requirements, you are <u>NOT</u> considered fully vaccinated and <u>are required to wear a mask when inside our facility</u>. We will not be requiring proof of vaccination but are relying on the integrity of our members and guests to follow this guidance based on their vaccination status.

Additional sanitizing stations are located throughout the building (frequent hand washing is encouraged)

Membership Office Hours: Monday through Thursday: 9:15 am to 11:30 am

Eligibility: Membership is open to anyone in the greater Nashua area age 50 or older.

Membership and Renewal Fees: \$40 per year for individuals; \$60 per year for two individuals residing at the same address.

Membership Renewal by Mail: Include a *self-addressed stamped envelope* to have your membership card and receipt mailed to you; otherwise, pick up your card and receipt when you visit the Center.

Veterans Discount: Eligible military service veterans receive a \$5 discount.

Membership Fee Exemption: Membership fee is waived for seniors 90 years and older.
